Administrative

- Monitor budgets and spending
 - Payroll, meal program and facilities budgets
- Submit payroll to OHS Penticton on required dates
- Recruit players/students to the camp
- Facilitate training session and orientate all instructor and counselors
- Develop staff schedules for each week
- Ensure completion of report cards, awards and player evaluations
- Ensure all students receive a report card and evaluation
- Accept player registrations on site, as required
- Communicate with the facility on all schedule changes or anything that is needed to operate the camp
- Attend various local tournaments and other promotional events to market OHS programs and sell positions
- Field customer complaints and resolve them in an effective and timely manner
- Distribute marketing material (OHS and OHA) within the local market at rinks and other hockey related facilities
- Communicate directly with the appropriate people in the Edmonton Oilers organization to ensure camp operations and marketing is being coordinated at the appropriate levels

Hockey Program

- Supervise Instructors and Counselors, providing guidance and feedback
 - Ensure they are implementing the on ice and off-ice programs put together by Senior Director of Hockey Operations
- Supervise Video Coordinator and ensure video is completed, oversee video analysis
- Oversee on-ice hockey program, goalie program and off-ice training program
- Instruct as required



- Conducts evaluations on all staff members and corrects their teaching techniques if required
- Discipline staff if required
